1. Context and Purpose of the Event

The multiplier event organized in the framework of the PRO-VES project – Promotion of Volunteering in Providing First Aid in Emergency Situations – took place in Rome, Italy, as part of Work Package 5: Multiplication and Dissemination of Results. This event served as a key moment to disseminate the project's results and promote volunteering as an essential tool for safety, solidarity, and social cohesion.

The primary aim of the event was to publicly present the outcomes, methods, and tools developed through the PRO-VES project, while also increasing awareness about the role of volunteers in providing first aid during emergencies. Additionally, it aimed to encourage civic participation and strengthen local collaboration networks among organizations, institutions, and citizens.

Aligned with the priorities of the Erasmus+ programme, the event promoted inclusion, civic engagement, adult education, and European cooperation. With its open and participatory approach, the event helped build a culture of responsibility and community preparedness for critical situations.

The participants included a diverse and representative group: volunteers, healthcare professionals, educators, NGO representatives, local authorities, and community members, reflecting the inclusive nature of the PRO-VES project and the relevance of the topic.

2. Event Objectives

❖ General Objective

To create a space for information, learning, and dialogue that promotes volunteering in first aid and disseminates the PRO-VES project results at local and regional levels.

❖ Specific Objectives

1. Disseminate PRO-VES project results, including the psycho-social guide for volunteers and educational materials developed throughout the project;
2. Promote the values of volunteering in emergency situations and highlight the active role of citizens in saving lives;
3. Raise awareness about the importance of practical training in first aid;
4. Encourage civic engagement and community participation, especially among adults and young people;
5. Strengthen inter-institutional collaboration among local organizations, NGOs, and authorities;
6. Ensure the sustainability and visibility of the project by promoting continued use of the PRO-VES results.

3. Event Structure and Activities

The multiplier event was organized as a one-day activity with a balanced format combining informative sessions, hands-on activities, and networking opportunities.

❖ Session I – Participant Registration and Opening Remarks

The event began with welcoming participants and an opening session. Representatives of the host organization presented the PRO-VES project context, the objectives of the event, and the relevance of the Erasmus+ programme in supporting civic education and volunteering.

❖ Session II – Presentation of the PRO-VES Project

This session focused on the overall presentation of the project, the international partnership, and activities conducted in Romania, Cyprus, and Italy. It highlighted

the training methodologies used and the project's impact on volunteers and communities.

✧ **Session III – Thematic Session: The Role of Volunteering in Emergency Situations**

Participants engaged in a thematic discussion about the importance of volunteering in first aid interventions. Key points included the role of civic preparedness and collaboration between citizens and institutions in managing emergencies.

✧ **Session IV – Practical Workshops: First Aid Demonstrations**

This central moment of the event included practical workshops where participants observed first aid demonstrations and practiced basic techniques. The hands-on component transformed theoretical knowledge into a valuable learning experience.

✧ **Session V – Presentation of the Psycho-Social Guide for Volunteers**

The session featured the presentation of the psycho-social education guide developed in the project. Participants appreciated the guide's usefulness in providing emotional and psychological support to volunteers.

✧ **Session VI – Conclusions and Certificate Distribution**

The event concluded with a session of reflections and the awarding of participation certificates. Organizers emphasized the importance of continuing the PRO-VES initiatives and fostering active community engagement.

4. Results and Impact

4.1. Concrete Results

- Participation of 70 individuals from various professional and social backgrounds;
- Dissemination of PRO-VES educational materials (psycho-social guide, informative content);
- Delivery of first aid demonstrations with direct involvement of participants;

- Strengthened relationships among local organizations and community stakeholders.

4.2. Impact on Participants

Participants gained:

- Practical knowledge on administering first aid;
- A deeper understanding of the role of volunteering in emergencies;
- Increased motivation to engage in civic and volunteer activities.

Informal feedback collected showed a high level of satisfaction and interest in continuing similar initiatives.

4.3. Impact on the Community and Host Organization

The event contributed to:

- Raising local visibility for the PRO-VES project;
- Promoting a culture of prevention and solidarity;
- Strengthening the host organization's capacity in non-formal education and volunteering.

5. Conclusions and Recommendations

The PRO-VES multiplier event in Italy stands as a good practice in Erasmus+ dissemination, showcasing the effectiveness of combining theoretical presentations with hands-on activities and community dialogue.

Conclusions:

- ✓ The event's objectives were fully achieved;
- ✓ Participants showed increased interest in volunteering and first aid training;
- ✓ The PRO-VES results were seen as useful, relevant, and easy to apply.

Recommendations:

- ◆ Organize similar events regularly at local and regional levels;
- ◆ Expand practical workshops for various target groups;
- ◆ Continue disseminating PRO-VES materials through Erasmus+ networks and local partnerships.



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
