# IMPACT REPORT

## **Multiplier Event Organized by RIVENSCO – Cyprus**

Project: PRO VES – Promoting Volunteering in Emergency Situations

Programme: Erasmus+ KA220-ADU

## **1. Objective of the Event**

The multiplier event organized by RIVENSCO aimed to capitalize on and extend the results of the PRO VES project at community and institutional level. The activity was designed as a space for reflection and strategic dialogue on the role of volunteering in strengthening emergency response capacity.

The main objective was to transform the project results – the psycho-social guide, awareness campaigns, and exchange activities – into practical tools applicable at local level, through the direct involvement of relevant stakeholders.

## **2. Structure and Implementation**

The event brought together more than 62 participants, including volunteers, representatives of public administration, educators, NGOs, and members of the local community.

The programme was structured around three main components:

1. **Informative component** – presentation of the PRO VES project results, its European impact, and the values promoted by the Erasmus+ programme.
2. **Educational component** – highlighting the importance of psycho-social preparedness in emergency interventions and presenting the guide as a replicable tool.

3. **Participatory component** – interactive discussion session focused on community needs and concrete ways of engaging in volunteering activities.

### **3. Impact at Individual Level**

The event generated a high level of active engagement among participants.

According to the collected feedback:

- over 85% of participants stated that they gained a clearer understanding of the role they can play in supporting the emergency system;
- 80% expressed increased interest in further training;
- the majority appreciated the integrated approach (technical and psycho-social) to emergency interventions.

Participants emphasized that volunteering should not be seen as a one-time action, but as a long-term civic commitment.

### **4. Institutional and Strategic Impact**

For RIVENSCO, the event had significant strategic value. Discussions were initiated regarding:

- integrating project materials into local training programmes;
- future collaboration with educational institutions;
- developing joint initiatives with local authorities in the field of prevention.

The event strengthened the organization's position as a facilitator of dialogue between civil society and public institutions in the field of emergency management.

### **5. Community Impact**

At community level, the activity contributed to:

- increasing the visibility of volunteering as a complementary resource to professional services;
- developing a culture of shared responsibility;
- promoting European values of solidarity and cooperation.

The distributed materials and digital resources presented during the event ensured that the impact extended beyond the event itself.

## **6. Added Value and Sustainability**

An important outcome of the event was the consolidation of a local network of stakeholders interested in developing volunteering in emergency situations. RIVENSCO intends to continue organizing similar sessions and to integrate PRO VES results into future projects.

The psycho-social guide and campaign materials remain available as open educational resources, contributing to the sustainability of the project's impact.

## **7. Conclusion**

The multiplier event organized by RIVENSCO had a significant educational, institutional, and community impact. Through its strategic and participatory approach, the activity transformed the results of the PRO VES project into concrete tools for strengthening civic engagement and emergency response capacity.

The event demonstrated that volunteering, supported by training and European cooperation, can become a key factor in building a more prepared and resilient community.
